Safe Drive Stay Alive (SDSA) Bernie Grant Art Centre 14/15/16 March 2018

We are pleased to be hosting this SDSA production again in March 2018.

SDSA is an informative, empowering production for our young people aged 16 and over. Recommended for passengers, learner drivers and those already hold a driving licence.

The production consists of a bespoke film and messages delivered live by working members of the emergency services and emotional speeches from a victim's relative and a survivor of their own road traffic collision.

The focus is on key messages of peer pressure, distraction, speed, wearing seat belts and drink/drug driving.

SDSA is fully supported by TfL and all emergency services. In terms of impact, there is no other educational production that we would recommend to our schools, that delivers all of these potentially life saving messages. We appreciate that attending SDSA does mean a few hours away from formal education, but we cannot measure how many young people do change behaviour and so avoid becoming a tragic statistic. We can provide TfL's official evaluation of the scheme and a report from the post evaluation data from our own 2016 event, contact me for a copy.

Pre book seats by the end of term (Dec 2017) for Year 12 and 13 students for SDSA.

The best way to ensure that all of your eligible pupils are able to access the information is to adopt a 'whole group' policy, not an optional opt-in policy. We receive funding from Transport for London (TfL) which includes offering free transport to and from the venue.

Transport is ordered based on the seats pre-booked, as this is a high cost element to this project.

We want as many students as possible to attend however, please be aware we do book coaches to transfer your students and we still get charged when your students do not attend. The cost per student including coaches is $\pounds 12$ per head, therefore we reserve the right to recharge these costs to the school where the school fails to attend.
