Safe Drive Stay Alive (SDSA) Bernie Grant Art Centre 21/22/23 January 2019

SDSA in Haringey will be in January 2019. This powerful production for our young people aged 16 and over, is recommended for passengers, learner drivers and those already hold a driving licence. The production consists of a film and messages live by working members of the emergency services and emotional speeches from a victim's relative and a survivor of their own road traffic collision.

They focus on key messages: peer pressure, distraction, speed, wearing seat belts and drink/drug driving.

All emergency services and TfL support the SDSA programme, fully. It delivers potentially lifesaving messages. We do appreciate that attending SDSA does mean a few hours away from formal education, but we cannot measure how many young people change behaviour and avoid becoming a tragic statistic. We can provide TfL's official evaluation of the scheme and a report from the post evaluation data from our own recent event.

It is best to decide to bring the **whole group as 'work related learning'**, not ask them to attend if they want to. We receive funding from Transport for London (TfL) towards this, which includes offering coach transport to and from the venue. Transport is ordered for you based on the seats pre-booked; as this is a high cost element to this project cost per head is circa £15.

To book please complete the attached form with your first and second choice of date and time.

This way we can secure best price deal for the coach trips.

Nb We want as many students as possible to attend, we book coaches to transfer your students and we still get charged when your students do not attend. We reserve the right to recharge these costs to the school where the school fails to attend.

Charges will be sent to any schools who send less than 60% of the pupils they book for. (A 53-seat coach costs approx. £400.)
