‘an interactive educational training programme’

What is POW?

POW stands for **Protect Our Women**, a name chosen and owned by Young People in Haringey in consultations with Solace Women’s Aid.

The **POW Project** is an interactive educational training programme focused on workshop delivery and awareness raising on the 8 strands of Violence against Women and Girls (VAWG).

Topics **POW** covers:

- Domestic abuse
- Sexual violence
- Stalking & Harassment
- Violence against Women & Girls and Media
- Child Sexual Exploitation
- Female genital mutilation (FGM)
- Forced marriage
- ‘Honour’-based violence

Why POW?

After attending POW, Young People:

- can identify types of violence against women and girls and become aware of situations where someone may be at risk of violence
- understand the legal implications of each type of violence
- are aware of suitable sources that offer support

How do we deliver POW Project in your school?

POW covers one topic a week:

- 1) You pick and choose the topics that you want us to deliver
- 2) According to the number of topics, we decide on the number of weeks that POW will be at your school
- 3) You select the dates and timing that suits you

POW only needs from you to kindly...

- allocate some time, a classroom and a staff member for POW
- generate excitement for POW in your school
- recruit or select your young people for POW
- commit supporting the POW worker's presence in your school
