

INVITE : Let's talk PANTS!

The NSPCC's PANTS campaign has launched in Haringey to help support parents, carers, and relevant professionals to use the PANTS resources in conversations with children so that these adults can try to help keep children safe from sexual abuse. The campaign is being delivered in partnership with Haringey Council, Haringey Safeguarding Children Partnership and other local agencies working with children and families in the borough.

PANTS helps children understand that their body belongs to them; that they have the right to say no, and that they should try to talk to an adult they trust if they're upset or worried. The launch event will outline the importance of talking to children about this issue, the impact of sexual abuse on children and young people and how the PANTS resources support the Early Help and Prevention agenda.
