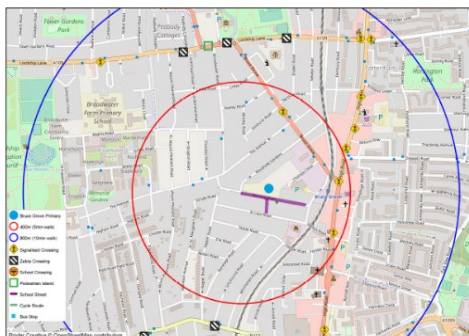
Because, to help our recovery from the last 2 years, will need us to be kind to each other, and ourselves;
