The online application process for children starting school in September 2023 opened on 1 September 2022. Haringey will also arrange further Reception and Secondary Transfer sessions via Microsoft Teams or Zoom with an opportunity for Q&A sessions after the presentation. Dates for these will be available on our website and the promotion leaflets will be sent to all schools in due course.

Each year we receive enquiries on whether we will be providing printed booklets. Please note our admissions prospectuses have been digital for a while, and schools are no longer provided with hard copies. Parents will be able to view the digital viewbooks <u>online</u> and will also need to apply for a school place via <u>e-admissions website (external link)</u>. The Secondary admissions viewbook includes information on the secondary school open events which are also available to view on our <u>website</u> (external link).

Please can you remind parents/carers to apply **on time** before the application deadlines for Reception and Secondary Transfer. We have a small number of families every year who forget to make an application, any late applications will not be considered until all on time offers have been made. With your help and support in publicising these deadlines and the imperative of making an on-time application, we can minimise the number of families who don't secure a school place at one of their preferred schools.
