Thank you to all schools last year for providing information about vacancies consistently every week in the 'weekly roll return'

As well as the critical safeguarding imperative of ensuring that children are appropriately tracked and monitored and referrals sent to the appropriate service, the purpose of the roll return is to ensure that we keep up to date figures on the availability of school places in the local area. This enables us to advise parents/carers of pupils moving into the area or wishing to transfer schools of the number of vacancies in the relevant year group.

This information is also essential to ensuring that pupils without a school place are offered their highest possible preference school at the earliest possible time.

The October census will be approaching very quickly, and we want to ensure that you have the maximum number of pupils on roll to maximize your funding. Please help us to do this by continuing to provide your weekly vacancy information.
