# Hands Up Survey how to:

Put your hand up to make a difference – follow these steps.

1 Open TfL STARS go to your school, open Surveys

2 Survey group

View and compare your pupil and staff surveys to monitor your progress and plan your targets for the year ahead.  
To apply for or maintain your level of accreditation each academic year, at least 90% of staff and pupils need to take the survey.

3 Add survey group

Set up your school survey group and name e.g. "Whole school (pupil and staff) hands-up survey 2016/17". You will then be able to complete individual surveys that feed into the group.

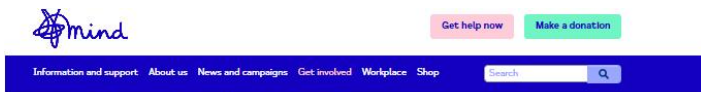
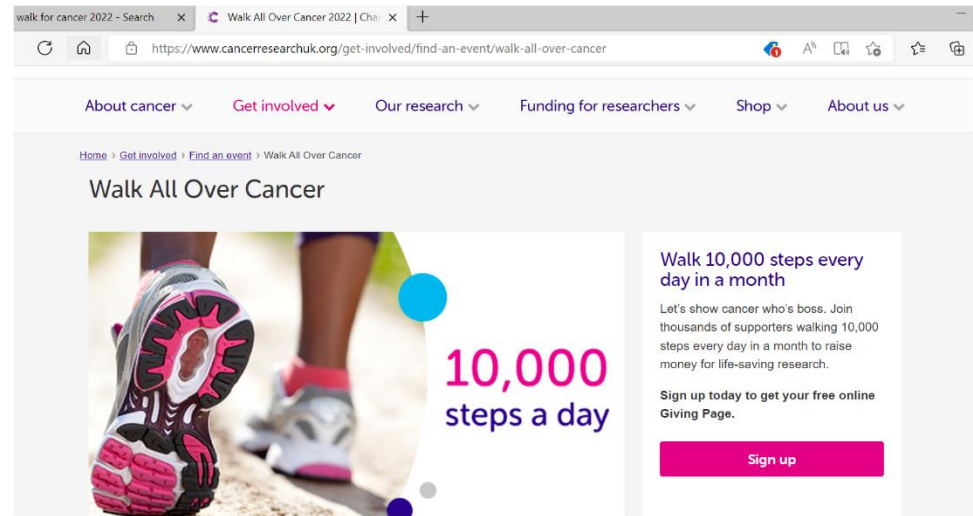
